Closest house to the college, just a 10 minute walk. Lovely houses, parks, heated outdoor swimming pool. Near the river, small restaurants, cafés and hotels.

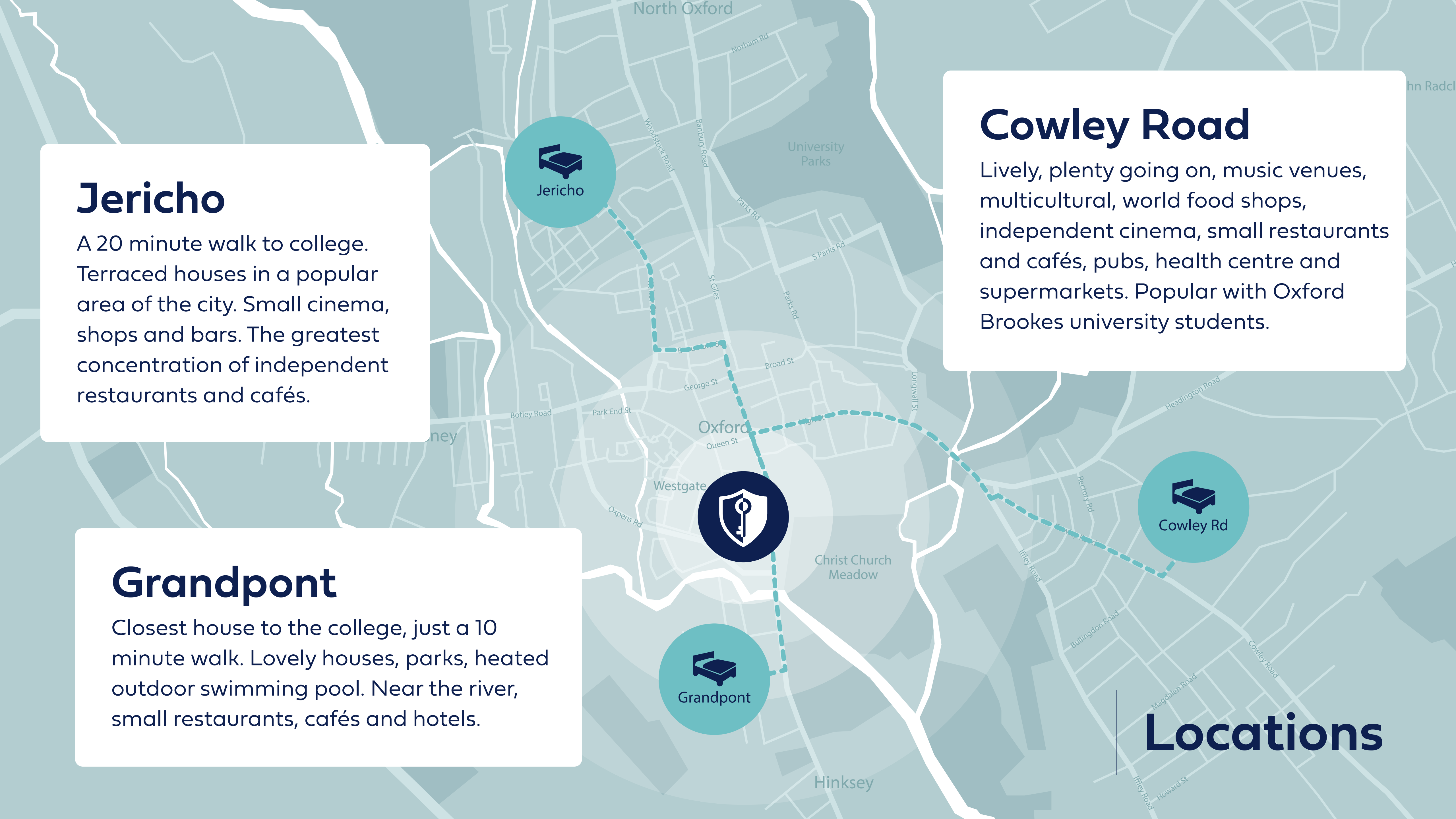


## Cowley Road

# Jericho

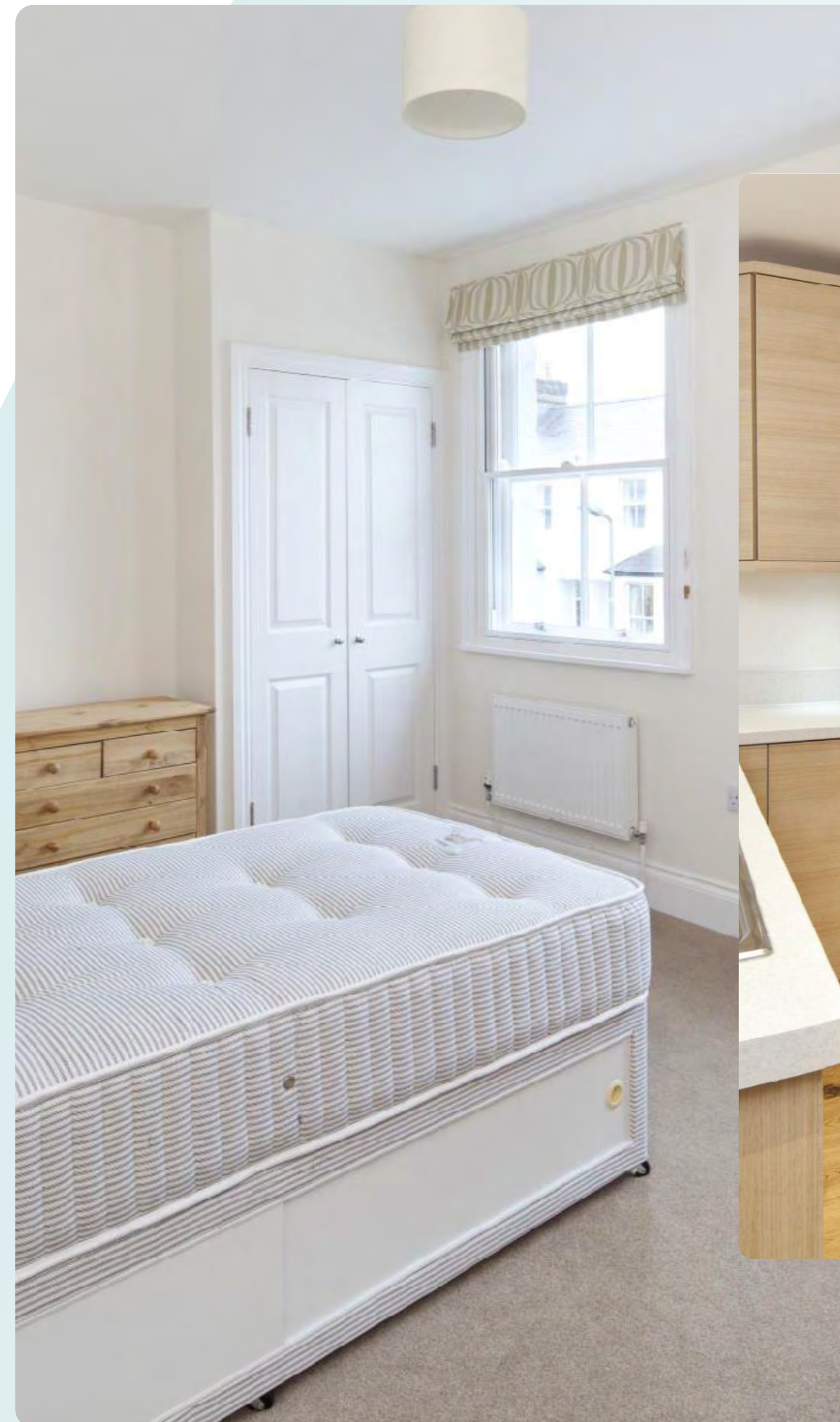
- Seven terraced houses.

- There are a few houses with ensuite bathrooms.
- Living rooms have television, sofas, dining table and chairs.
- Bring your own cushions or rugs to make you feel at home



# House Contents

- Kitchen equipment includes: crockery, utensils, saucepans, cooker, fridge/freezer, microwave, kettle, toaster, washing machine, cleaning equipment.
- Lounge furnished with sofas and TV.
- TV Licence provided by the College.
- Bedrooms furnished with bed, desk, chair and wardrobe.
- Bathrooms are shared.
- Every house has a second toilet.
- Students organise internet themselves on arrival.
- A noticeboard in each bedroom.
